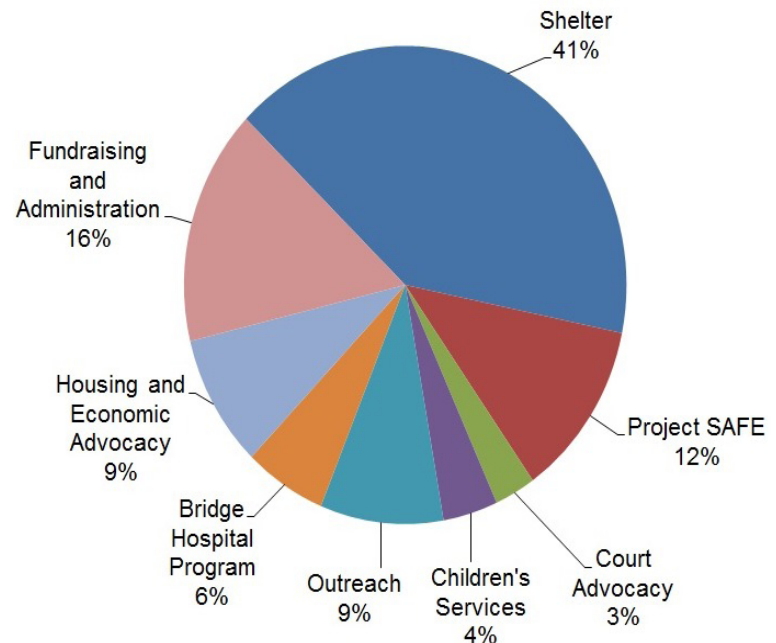
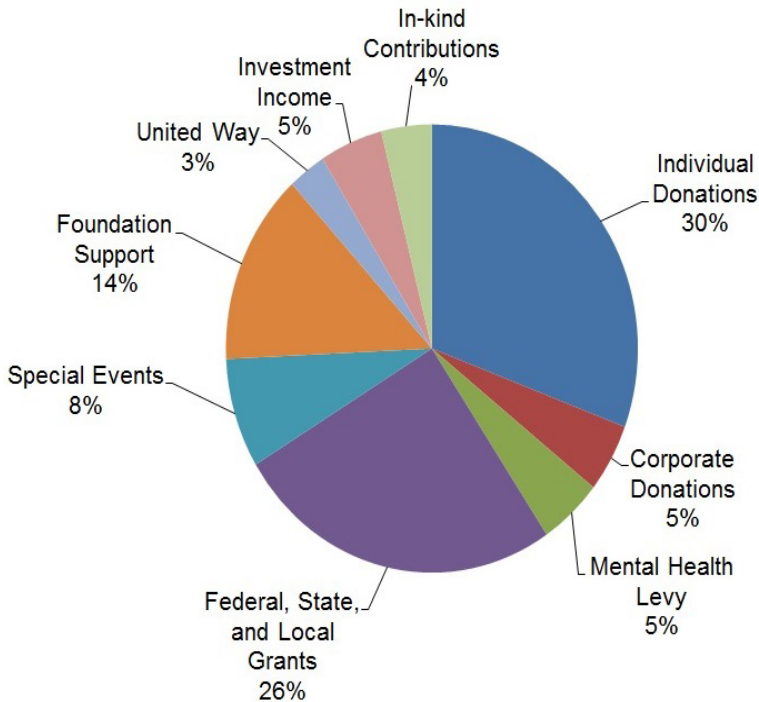


Agency Financials

Agency Snapshot – Fiscal Year Ending 2013

Violence Prevention

5,304 Students were provided support, groups, therapy, and education in violence prevention and healthy relationships through Project SAFE.

Community Advocacy

Rose Brooks Center staff answered **7,291** calls from women searching for help and support.

Advocates provided **1,182** domestic violence patients with 24/7 advocacy through the hospital-based Bridge Program.

Outreach Support

Therapists and Case Managers offered **3,863** hours of outreach counseling and support to **225** women and children.

Economic Advocacy

Advocates provided **2,164** hours of resume-writing and job training to provide financial stability and economic empowerment.

Volunteer Support

Volunteers gave **16,109** hours of their time to help support Rose Brooks Center's programs and services.

In 2013, Rose Brooks Center provided **46,787 safe nights** to women, children, and pets through shelter and transitional housing.
